



## APPLICATION TO REQUEST NEW YORK LMSW/LCSW CONTINUING EDUCATION HOURS FOR DSW ELECTIVE COURSES

### OVERVIEW

The DSW elective courses below have been approved for New York LMSW and LCSW continuing education hours through the University at Buffalo School of Social Work, Office of Continuing Education; recognized by the New York State Education Departments State Board for Social Work as an approved provider for continuing education for licensed social workers #SW-0001.

Each approved 3 credit DSW course is equal to 45 NYSED social work contact hours. If you have an out of state social work license, you will need to check with your state licensing board to determine if they will accept NYSED approved hours.

NYSED does not allow hours to be carried over from one license registration period to the next. In order to use hours earned from a DSW course, you must start and end the course within your three-year registration period.

### PROCESS

1. After you successfully complete the course complete and print this form.
2.
