

The two semester long project I would be completing would be an assessment of the Institute for Trauma Recovery and Resiliency's trauma informed care practices followed by a training and set of recommendations. The project would include looking at how our practice completes intakes over the phone, if an online version would be more accessible to people, how we are screening clients (all of whom have a history of trauma), how women are introduced into starting the Intensive Outpatient Program and other ways where our practice is mindful of working with those with a traumatic past. Some of the nine competencies that would be highlighted are demonstrating ethical and professional behavior, engaging in practice informed research and research informed practice, engaging with individuals, families, groups and communities, evaluating practice with individuals, families, groups and communities.



Competency 1: Demonstrate Ethical and Professional Behavior

Student will develop process where second hand trauma from working with our population is discussed during weekly clinical meetings and/or independent supervision. Student will spend time with supervisor exploring different activities or mechanisms of support that could be developed within our practice.

Competency 2: Engage Diversity and Difference in Practice

Student will work alongside supervisor and other senior clinicians to understand the importance of practicing culturally informed care with diverse populations. Due to large refugee population in the area, student will explore best practices working with those who have trauma and are in need of translation services.

Competency 3: Advanced Human rights a **Admin Save** omic and Environmental Justice

Student will gather local and stat Updated: 10/12/2021 11:14 AM sion, human rights and social justice to present within agency and/or develop resource guide for office use. Resources will be tailored based on the specific needs of populations served.

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Competency 4: Engage in Practice-informed Research and Research-informed Practice

Student will spend time analyzing current screening tools that our practice is using and work with supervisor and other clinicians to determine appropriateness of using them within client population, specific focus will include screenings on trauma and symptoms of post traumatic stress disorder.
